



Uniform & Dress Code Policy (2025–2026)

Uniform Shirts

All uniform tops must be purchased through **Brisk Apparel**:

- **Style:** Polo shirt or t-shirt
 - **Colors:** Red or Navy Blue
 - **Fit:** Loose-fitting, and must extend at least **2 inches below the hip socket**
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Uniform Bottoms (Boys & Girls)

May be purchased from **any store or uniform vendor**.

- **Approved Items:** Pants, shorts, capris, skorts, jumpers (girls only)
- **Colors:** Navy blue or khaki
- **Material/Style:** Must be *industrial uniform style* (e.g., Dockers).
 - ✗ **No athletic wear** (fleece, spandex, nylon, or stretchy materials)
 - ✗ **No baggy or low-rise pants**, oversized fits, holes, or slits
 - ✓ Shorts may cover the knee but **may not extend past the knee**
 - ✓ **Skirts/shorts/skorts must be to the knee**

◆ **Leggings or tights** (under skirts/skorts/dresses): Solid red, white, or navy only

◆ **Belts are not required**

Girls Plaid Items

Vendor: **French Toast** – www.frenchtoast.com

- **Approved Items:** Plaid skirts, skorts, and jumpers
 - **Color:** “Blue/red plaid” only
 - **Length:** To the knee
 - **Required:** Bicycle shorts under skirts
 - **Jumpers:** Permitted only through **2nd grade**
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Outerwear (Sweaters, Sweatshirts, Jackets)

- **Colors:** Solid red, white, or navy blue
- **✗ No visible brand logos**
- ✓ Freedom Academy logo sweatshirts available via **Brisk Apparel**
- Must fit appropriately — **no oversized or cropped styles**

Footwear & Accessories

- **Shoes:** Athletic shoes, boots, or flats
 - ✗ No Crocs, open-toe, or open-heel shoes
 - **Socks:** No color restrictions
 - **Hair:** Neat and clean; only natural hair colors allowed. IE: no pink, blue, purple, green, etc.
 - **Accessories:**
 - Headbands, bows, and scrunchies allowed if not distracting
 - Small stud earrings (max two per ear). No hoops, gauges, or dangles
 - Necklaces, rings, and bracelets allowed (must be subtle and school-appropriate)
 - **Makeup/Nails:** Must be natural tones and school-appropriate
 - **Hats/Caps:** Allowed outdoors only; must be removed indoors
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Freedom Friday Shirts

- A special **Friday shirt** is available each school year.
 - Students may wear **this year's** Freedom Friday shirt with jeans on Fridays only.
 - ✗ Shirts from previous years are not allowed.
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Non-Uniform Days (Free Dress Days)

All clothing must still adhere to the **spirit of the dress code**:

✔ Allowed:

- Shirts at least 2" below hip socket and long enough to cover the midriff (even when arms are raised)
- Jeans (no rips or holes; skinny jeans allowed **only** if paired with an appropriate top)
- Close-toed, rubber-soled shoes that stay on and are tied properly
- Appropriate logos and designs

✗ Not Allowed:

- Crop tops, tank tops, spaghetti straps, tube tops, backless clothing
 - Shorts, skirts, or skorts above the knee
 - Pajama pants/sets (unless part of a spirit day)
 - Clothing with skulls, weapons, profanity, drugs, alcohol, or tobacco
 - Torn or cut garments
 - Biker shorts
 - Hats, caps, or hoods indoors
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Violations & Consequences

Students who violate dress code may be required to:

- Call home for appropriate clothing
- Wait in the office until clothing is brought
- Change into school-provided attire
- Have activity restricted if shoes are unsafe
